This is a role with international responsibilities and includes 4-6 trips per year including global destinations, The Catalyst program is highly visible across the TM Forum organization and with TM Forum members, so we are seeking applicants who want to make a difference and get recognized for their contribution. In this role, you will be a hands-on, action oriented player in the comprehensive execution of the Catalyst Program, ensuring that it delivers against the needs of TM Forum membership and drives the objectives of the TM Forum Strategic Plan forward. As primary key outward facing point of contact for the Catalyst Program, the Project Manager is responsible for all aspects of the end-to-end coordination of the Catalyst Program. This position resides within the Collaboration Program team and interacts with virtually all other TM Forum teams.

Specific Responsibilities:

- Define, communicate and execute the necessary steps as agreed with the Catalyst Program
 Manager and assist him to guarantee the Catalyst Program delivers on its respective component
 of the TM Forum Strategic Plan continuously driving for increased value, relevance and
 innovation in the proposed set of catalysts.
- Establish the high level schedule for Catalyst Program deliverables and due dates for project participants.

- Manage logistics, contracts, timelines and status reporting for the Catalyst program and individual projects within the program
- Work with and project manage the Catalyst projects to ensure the Collaboration Program process is being adhered to including any intellectual property and delivery of final assets.
- Work as part of a cross functional team to ensure that the holistic demonstration of all Catalysts is well structured, has a strong flow and is effective for multiple different audiences.
- With the Events, IT and Marketing teams, ensure space, display areas and IT requirements are collected and addressed for the Live! Events and track through execution phase.
- Provide guidance to the Catalyst project teams ensuring a successful demonstration of their concepts.
- Conduct follow-up surveys and interviews to improve the Catalyst Program experience for both the project teams involved and the furtherance of TM Forum best practices and standards.

Skill Requirements:

- Bachelor's Degree (technical degree a plus) and 3 years' experience in a technical arena.
- Individual must be fiercely collaborative.
- Work-related experience with project management, preferably certified in PM.
- Exposure to or experience with (a plus) orchestrating and supporting large scale demonstration events.
- Candidate must have the flexibility and ability to travel internationally multiple times during the year from multi-day to week long trips and the ability to adjust quickly to time zones.
- Strong analytical, interpersonal, communication and organizational skills.
- Possess the ability to think strategically and communicate effectively
- Understanding of TM Forum's Frameworx is a plus.
- As a global organization, the ability to work with colleagues and project teams across multiple geographic locations and cultures.
- Strong computer skills with a working knowledge of MS Office and WordPress, and the ability to status and progress in a clear and concise manner.
- The use tools to report ability to manage multiple projects of varying size and at different points in their lifecycle is critical.
- Conflict resolution and diplomatic characteristics are desirable skills.
- The ability to manage stressful situations and make rapid informed decisions in changing environments is a requirement of this position.
